The heart of the matter

Don't get caught out in your hour of need. The defibrillator number is:

C159X

If you have access to a mobile, you can call 999. Ask for ambulance and they will give you the number to open the defibrillator box.

If the patient is not breathing you should be doing chest compressions and someone else running to get the defibrillator. It is therefore very important that you know one or two numbers of nearby neighbours, who could do the running.
