Update 2 - PTO

The **Neighbourhood Plan** (NP) Steering Group met on 1 July 2021 for its first meeting and good progress has already been made. 18 members of the Parish have volunteered for the Steering Group and 5 for a drafting Group. The drafting Group has already produced the first outline draft of the NP using material from the Parish and Community led plans and the recent Parish Council survey results.

The Steering Group has agreed to pursue a Character assessment of the Parish followed by developing Parish specific Planning Policies and Design Codes.

The Steering Group Minutes and the latest draft of the NP, as it evolves will be uploaded to the Binfield Heath website so that Parishioners may keep themselves up to date
