All Souls Day – 2 Nov

The usual All Souls evening service will take place at Shiplake Church, but as this usually attracts 50+ people, not all can be accommodated. Pam, Sarah and Robert will each be in one of the three churches from 11am – 4pm with a short service on the hour, every hour, so that people can now in light a candle and take a moment to contemplate. At 7.30pm all the names of those who have been remembered in the three churches will be read out at a special service at Shiplake Church.
