Hello again everyone. This is the fourth of our newsletters to keep you up to date on where we are with the Binfield Heath Neighbourhood Plan. Once adopted by South Oxfordshire District Council, the Plan can help to influence planning matters and preserve the character of the parish.

We are making steady progress. A Landscape Character Assessment based on feedback from parishioners is expected to be completed soon. It aims to identify what gives Binfield Heath its unique identity and which aspects of the landscape we want to preserve and protect. One important feature is what remains of the ancient heath that gave the parish its name.



The parish Design Guide is also well under way. Following consultation with residents, this seeks to ensure that any new building fits in with its surroundings based on height, scale, design and materials used.



A history of the parish, which forms another part of the Neighbourhood Plan, is nearly finished. But we would still love to hear any stories, secrets and legends you may have about your house, the pubs, or the parish in general. You can contact us by email at:


